



About the park

Developed from 258 acres of native mangrove-lined shores and intertwined waterways, E.G. Simmons Conservation Park includes 200 acres of mangrove swamp that is preserved as a bird and wildlife sanctuary. Birdwatchers can view protected species such as the roseate spoonbill and the bald eagle. Visitors can take a leisurely stroll on the 700-foot stretch of beach along Tampa Bay, fish on the pier and from shore, kayak through mangrove islands, or set up camp at one of the park's 103 campsites complete with electricity, potable water, picnic tables, and fire rings.
